*We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. Between 7/1/2021 and 9/30/2021, we failed to submit the required samples as indicated below and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.*

**What happened? What is being done?** (Describe corrective action)

Water sample results were submitted on time and within allowable range. This violation is for using the correct 911 street address at the location, where the samples were taken. The West Virginia Bureau for Public Health only has the street name listed in their system and not the exact address. Since their computer system cannot differentiate between an exact street address and a street name a violation is generated stating that we failed to report correctly.

In the future we will strive to achive compliance by not using the correct address.
